



### Pit Area and Grid Rules

We have grown increasingly concerned with the practice of running Kid Kart engines at full throttle, on the stand in both the pit and grid area.

This has resulted in numerous instances of blown up motors that, in some cases, ejected parts into surrounding areas. Additionally the practice of running on stands raises the issue of rapidly turning wheels just inches` from the heads and hands of young drivers. We have been very fortunate that no serious injuries or deaths have occurred.

**Accordingly we are implementing the following regulations for the grid and pit areas:**

- 1) The practice of running engines at high rpm's for extended periods will no longer be allowed in pits, pre-grid or grid areas.
- 2) When in the pre-grid area no running is allowed
- 3) When in grid area the engines may only be run on the ground not on stands.
- 4) When fuel is supplied you will be allowed a minimum amount of low RPM running to ensure the fuel has reached the carburetor. This will only be allowed when under the direct supervision of a designated race official.

We realize that it is frequently necessary to run the engine after maintenance; this will only be permitted at modest RPM levels for limited periods of time. Extended running at RPMs above clutch stall speeds to preheat motors prior to racing is no longer permitted.

Remember safety first!!

**Failure to adhere to these revised regulations may result in disqualification.**

### **Grid Etiquette:**

Closed-toe shoes and shirts are required for any person on the grid. No flip flops or open toe shoes please. No smoking anywhere except your pit area.

The grid area will be very congested throughout the weekend. Only one crewmember per kart is allowed. Please keep other children off the grid and in the viewing area.

Kart stands are not allowed on the grid. Please move your kart stand to the appropriate area before your practice or race session begins.

### **Fencing, Rocks, Restrooms**

No person or children are to climb any of the fences at any time

Absolutely NO rock throwing of any kind (*not even in puddles of water*)

No beating on the doors of the restrooms

Please be respectful of everyone at the races and help keep the Johnny on the Spots as clean as possible

Put the paper towels in the trashcans; if you see trash on the ground please help by picking it up and putting in a trashcan.
